

Curfew Policy

BE IT RESOLVED, that is the intent of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Union Vale Fire District to establish a Curfew policy for all members of the Union Vale Fire District and Union Vale Fire Department subject to the following guidelines:

1. All members and explorers under the age of eighteen are required to leave the station by 2200 hours (10 p.m.). The only exception to this rule is if the member has responded on a call prior to 2200 hours (10 p.m.) or the call starts after 2200 hours (10 p.m.) and the call runs past the curfew, or a drill, truck, or meeting is extended. Any exception to this policy must be approved by an officer of the Union Vale Fire Company.
2. All members and explorers under the age of eighteen WILL NOT be permitted to be in the fire station with a NON- Union Vale Fireman, unless an active Firefighter over the age of 18 is present.
3. There will be no sleeping overnight in the firehouses (both members and guests), except for declared emergencies, and unless approved by a Chief Officer.
4. Guests – All guests must be over the age of 18, and are required to leave the station by 2300 hours (11 p.m.). Each member can only bring one (1) guest to the firehouse.

Any violations of the above guidelines shall result in disciplinary action by the Chief and the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Union Vale Fire District.
