

RED LIGHTS & SIRENS BY EMTs

New York State law allows emergency medical technicians to use red lights and sirens in their private vehicles under certain circumstances and when carrying certain equipment. The Fire District has the authority to prohibit such actions. Therefore, it is the policy of the Union Vale Fire District that no emergency medical technician shall equip or operate their personal vehicle with red lights and sirens.

This policy shall not apply to emergency medical technicians who are District Chief officers or are County fire officials and are performing their duties as such under New York State law.
