Procedure:

District personnel may arrive at the scene of an EMS call where the patient cannot be located. Every effort must be made to locate the patient before leaving the scene. Crew members should question bystanders, if available, for information. The crew should make a reasonable search in order to find the patient. Dutchess 911 should be contacted for additional information and to attempt to contact the initial caller.
